




System is Confusing



Health Care Reform - Obama


- Reduce long-term growth of health care costs for businesses and government
- Protect families from bankruptcy or debt because of health care costs
- Guarantee choice of doctors and health plans
- Invest in prevention and wellness
- Improve patient safety and quality of care
- Assure affordable, quality health coverage for all Americans
- Maintain coverage when you change or lose your job
- End barriers to coverage for people with pre-existing medical conditions

Health Care Reform - Baucus



- Approach
 - Increased access offset by comparative effectiveness
 - Insurance market reforms
 - Tax code changes
- Features
 - Expanded Medicaid Eligibility
 - Pay or play mandate for employers
 - •Increased transparency: quality, costs, outcomes
 - Increase primary care access
 - Reform tax code (tax increases)
 - Focus on prevention




